## Fairfield Public Schools Hires Woodard & Curran for PCB Review

With the finding of PCB's at Osborn Hill School, the Fairfield Public Schools, in conjunction with the Town of Fairfield, will be initiating a comprehensive review of the potential for PCB's at all of its school buildings. As professional expertise is required to conduct this review, the school district has retained the firm of Woodard & Curran to develop a short-term and long-term management program for the potential existence of PCB's in all of its schools.

The firm will survey the district's school buildings and present a probability finding for the different schools as it relates to the potential presence of PCB's in building materials and the potential risk to students and staff in the buildings. The building survey will be conducted in November and December of 2012 and findings will be presented in January 2013.
