Osborn Hill Elementary School Kindergarten Rooms Odor Issue

I am writing to provide you with an update on the above referenced project. We have fixed and replaced the broken rain water piping which runs out to the main sewer catch basins. This line is 12 inches in diameter, made of concrete, and runs under the playground. In addition, we have relined the cast iron piping (approximately 53 feet long) directly under the kindergarten classrooms. I am happy to report that we corrected all the issues and I am pleased with the results.

We have provided reports for moisture testing of the concrete slabs, VOC testing (Volatile Organic Compounds) by the State of Connecticut Department of Public Health in conjunction with the Director of Health, Sands Cleary, and mold testing by an outside Certified Industrial Hygienist, Hygenix Inc. I am happy to report that all tests have come back with the designation "Clean Building". These reports will be posted on our website.
