Approval of Minutes:

The minutes of the 8/28/13, 9/11/13 & 9/25/13 meetings were approved 6/0

Architect Interviews:

Four architectural firms were interviewed. The firms were:

- Ti Soo Kim
- Antinozzi
- Fletcher Thompson
- Perkins Eastman

Each firm made a presentation to the committee followed by a Q&A period.

Selection of an architectural firm:

The committee scored each firm based on quality. Five of the six committee members had Perkins Eastman as their first choice.

Then the firm's fee proposals were opened and reviewed. The total fees based on \$9,500,000 of construction value ranged from NTE \$640,000 to \$751,000. Perkins Eastman's fee was NTE \$728,250.

There was a lengthy discussion of the firms and fees.

A motion was made to select Perkins Eastman as the architect for the project. Motion passed 6/0.

The next meeting of the FLHSBC is on 10/30/13.
