In an effort to support our students as they learn math, the Fairfield Public Schools (FPS) is providing an on-line, interactive math forum to all current FPS students that are enrolled or have been enrolled in Algebra I. This forum will include a certified secondary math teacher who will interact with and support students during the after school hours for 3 hours per week.

A FPS teacher will be available during the following days and hours:

Wednesday 7 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.
Thursday 3:30 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Please note, the support provided by the teacher will only be done during the hours provided above. However, students can pose questions between themselves, along with questions to the teacher outside of the hours posted. The teacher will not be able to assist outside of the hours listed. Additionally, the questions posed should be limited to Algebra I concepts and skills only.

To access this support, the student will need to sign up. Use the link <http://fairfieldschools.org/apps/math-signup/> to sign up electronically. The processing time to activate the account will take up to 5 business days. Once the student account is set up, the student will be sent the access and login information to his or her school.

Project Status:

Chairman Quinn reported that several meetings regarding the project design have taken place with various town department and FPS staff. These meetings will continue through the ongoing design process. He noted that he had mailed out 85 invitations this meeting to abutting and nearby property owners so that they can learn more about the project and ask questions. He also wanted to hear the concerns of the residents for inclusion in the design if appropriate.

Presentation:

Attorney Fallon acted as the moderator for the public presentation. The presentation was given by the design and construction teams. Items reviewed were the building design, construction phasing and schedule, mechanical systems and site drainage. The presentation took approximately 45 minutes.

Public Q&A:

Approximately a dozen people took the opportunity to comment or ask questions. There were a few questions asking for clarification on certain items such as the placement of the dumpster or the landscaping. Most of the questions/comments concerned traffic especially around drop off and pickup times. The concerns were not focused in one location. Also there were a few people who expressed concerns about runoff to the south end of the property.

At the end of the Q&A session the Chairman thanked the public for their participation.
