- 3. Anna Cutaia-Leonard and Sheila Ferrara provided an update on the elementary pilot program. A parent meeting was held on October 13th of the students who are in the pilot program at Sherman, Dwight and North Stratfield. Data will be collected through student/parent/teacher surveys, rubrics and observations on the effectiveness of the program.
