TECHNOLOGY

1. Begin to implement new student management system (Infinite Campus)
2. Develop/revise the technology distribution model (hardware)
3. Develop a district-wide approval process for technology resources (hardware and software)
4. Implement the employee self-service component of the Human Resources software (paper reduction)
5. Computerize reservations, work order and field trip approval systems
6. Develop a rubric to assess staff skill levels and target professional development in technology
