- 1. In what ways did the English colonies develop differently from the Spanish and the French colonies?
- 2. "From the beginning, the English colonies had democratic characteristics."

Assess the validity of this statement with reference to majority rule and representative government in Virginia and Massachusetts.

Chapter 3 Empires pages 73-104

- 1. Compare and contrast the English relationship and the French relationship with the Native Americans.
- 2. "Beginning with the restoration of the monarchy in 1660, the English government made a continuous effort to exercise control over its American colonies."
