Re: Cornell Road Bridge

The Town of Fairfield will be closing the Cornell Road bridge to motor vehicles and pedestrians on October 8, 2012. The construction of the new Cornell Road bridge is expected to be completed in January of 2013. As the Town monitors the project and the schedule we will communicate to you exact completion dates for the reopening of Cornell Road.

With the pedestrian traffic being diverted we have arranged for 2 buses to transport students to and from Fairfield Warde High School. Fairfield Public Schools have contacted The Unquowa School (Bus # 3) to provide a safe location for students for pick up and drop off as well as another bus to be located at Lincoln Park (Bus # 26) at the corner of Jackman Avenue and Fairmont Terrace for pick up and drop off of students that go to Fairfield Warde High School.

The buses will depart from The Unquowa School at 7:10 AM and from Lincoln Park at 7:05 AM. In the afternoon Bus # 3 & #26 will depart Fairfield Warde High School to drop off the students after the daily dismissal time.
